



Hair prep

WHETHER YOU'RE EXCHANGING VOWS OR CELEBRATING WITH THE HAPPY COUPLE, YOU'LL WANT YOUR HAIR TO LOOK AMAZING!

HERE ARE SOME TIPS TO HELP YOU PREPARE YOUR HAIR FOR THE BIG DAY.

- PLEASE ENSURE YOUR HAIR IS COMPLETELY DRY UPON ARRIVAL. STYLING DAMP OR WET HAIR IS TIME-CONSUMING AND MAY LIMIT THE TIME AVAILABLE TO CREATE YOUR DESIRED LOOK, POTENTIALLY CAUSING DELAYS ON THE DAY.
- YOUR HAIR SHOULD BE CLEAN AND FREE FROM PRODUCT OR OIL BUILD-UP, AS STYLES WILL NOT HOLD WELL ON DIRTY HAIR. FOR MOST CLIENTS, WASHING THE NIGHT BEFORE OR THE MORNING OF THE WEDDING IS IDEAL.
- WHEN WASHING, SHAMPOO YOUR HAIR TWICE. APPLY CONDITIONER TO THE MID-LENGTHS AND ENDS ONLY, AVOIDING THE ROOTS, AND RINSE THOROUGHLY. USE YOUR USUAL SHAMPOO AND CONDITIONER RATHER THAN TRYING NEW PRODUCTS.
- WHEN BLOW-DRYING, AIM FOR A SMOOTH FINISH USING A PADDLE OR ROUND BRUSH AND YOUR REGULAR STYLING PRODUCTS.
- IF YOU HAVE NATURALLY CURLY HAIR AND PLAN TO WEAR IT CURLY, APPLY YOUR NORMAL CURL PRODUCTS AND ALLOW IT TO DRY NATURALLY OR DIFFUSE. I WILL REFINE AND ENHANCE YOUR CURLS DURING STYLING.
- FOR NATURALLY CURLY HAIR THAT WILL BE STYLED SMOOTH OR STRAIGHT, PLEASE ENSURE IT IS BLOW-DRYED AS SMOOTHLY AS POSSIBLE AHEAD OF YOUR APPOINTMENT.
- DECIDE ON YOUR PREFERRED PARTING FOR THE DAY AND DRY YOUR HAIR IN THAT POSITION, AS CHANGING THE PART ONCE SET CAN BE DIFFICULT.
- PLEASE AVOID TYING YOUR HAIR INTO A PONYTAIL TO PREVENT CREASES OR FLATTENING — A LOW PONY USING A SILK SCRUNCHIE IS PREFERRED.
